# Gas Tax = Better Roads?

45¢ Gas tax = \$2.5B for roads earmarked in **My Governors** proposed budget.

Plus hoping for \$1B from Federal Government

\$1.2B was approved in 2015

This year will contribute an extra \$880M

tax is now at 26.3¢ + 6% Sales tax per gallon.

Estimated to be 44.13¢ (**6<sup>th</sup> highest in nation**)

+ 18.4¢ federal excise tax

Increase of 15 ¢ Oct. 1 2019, April 1, 2020, and Oct. 1, 2020.







# Campaign Promises

- Michigan would suffer the highest fuel tax in the United States




